The New Jersey Licensed Beverage Association (NJLBA) is honored to recognize Mr. Joseph DeMarco, Chairman of the Board of Directors for High Grade Beverage Companies, for his continued support and participation in the association's annual convention during the past 50 years.

Started in 1932 in Atlantic City, the annual convention brings together the members of the state's licensed beverage industry to share their successes, concerns and business goals and plans for the future, explained NJLBA executive director Diane Weiss.

"It's truly a privilege for the association to recognize Mr. DeMarco, who has supported the convention for five decades," Weiss said. "He has seen significant changes and growth in the industry through the years, and we're proud to recognize his commitment to both the association and the convention at this year's event."

Mr. DeMarco's family roots in the industry go back to 1940, when his father was one of the founding partners in High Grade Beverage, a franchised beer wholesaler, based in Middlesex and Morris counties. Twenty-one years later, Mr. DeMarco became President and CEO of the company, and began further expanding the business.

Joined by his son Anthony, who took over as President and CEO of the business in 2005, Mr. DeMarco continues to play an active role in the company's operations. Serving approximately seven counties in central and northwestern New Jersey, High Grade can warehouse, in the South Brunswick facility alone, more than a half million cases of beer in an environmentally-controlled setting, as well as another 250,000 cases in a non-environmentally controlled area.

He is a member of the New Jersey Beer Wholesalers Association and serves on their Executive Committee. In addition to his work in the alcohol beverage industry, Mr. DeMarco is active in a wide range of charitable activities throughout the state, and has been recognized twice with humanitarian awards.

Mr. DeMarco will be recognized for his contributions to the alcohol beverage industry at the 2011 convention's formal dinner, scheduled for Wednesday evening, November 2, at the Tropicana Casino and Resort in Atlantic City.

Annual "News from the Lobby"

Well, 2011 has been quite a year for the NJLBA and for the hospitality sector in general. With the economy mired in the worst intractable rut since the Great Depression and New Jersey's economy beset with among the nation's highest levels of unemployment, these are indeed troubled times. At this point in time, close to 30% of retail licensees are on default. We all know that the off-premises bars, taverns and restaurants are always at the bleeding edge of a tight dollar. For the past year I have been proud to be on the NJLBA team as we dig in for a last stand on that bleeding edge.

One would think that, in light of the great economic challenges we as a State and as an industry face, the New Jersey Legislature would be working overtime to assist our sector with its hundreds of thousands of jobs and hundreds of thousands of families hanging in the balance. That is not the case. Instead of a receptive ear and strong support, we have been forced to play staunch defense. We have witnessed our staunch legislative heroes like Speaker Sheila Oliver and Assembly Majority Leader Joe Cryan and Senators Nick Sacco, Kip Bateman and Sean Kean, but, unfortunately we are in the middle of yet another year where we are constantly in a state of agitation and readiness to defeat without compromise bills ranging from permitting the direct to consumer shipments of alcohol, to wine and beer license bills, to grocery and chain liquor store domination bills, to statewide pocket license transfer bills.

The NJLBA has been at the forefront of the battles against this long list of destructive legislation since 1933 and 2011 has been no exception. The NJLBA, with our resurgent and surging membership, remains an effective voice in Trenton on the direct shipment legislation – most recently driving home its opposition to permitting winery outlets the privilege to sell wine by the glass. The NJLBA is instrumental as an industry voice across the

full spectrum of deeply troubling legislation. The NJLBA is also a presence in the Governor's Office – where we are a welcome voice on behalf of thousands of small businesses across New Jersey.

2011 is not just any ordinary year. As the first legislative election year following the Federal census and resulting new legislative district map, 2011 will end in the middle of the kind of Lame Duck legislative session that only comes around once every ten years. From November 8, 2011 through January 10, 2012, the New Jersey Legislature will be in session with many of the members present and voting in their last session before they leave office. History has demonstrated a high degree of volatility under these conditions.

When taken together – a deeply sour economy with nearly a third of licensed retailers on default along with powerful, misguided legislators aggressively pursuing an anti-hospitality sector agenda in the context of a Diennial Lame Duck Legislature - we get a potential perfect storm for damage.

As you plan your Holiday Season schedule, please put a "hold" on every Monday and Thursday (this is when the Legislature meets during Session) and be prepared to come to Trenton to protect your businesses. In addition, take very chance you get to meet with your elected representatives throughout the year to express your opposition to the bad legislation discussed above.

A year ago, shortly after being named as Legislative Agent for the NJLBA, I presented my first Report and stated at its outset that both myself and MBI GluckShaw were proud to be your governmental affairs representatives and that you could count on us to aggressively defend your interests. It has been our pleasure and honor to work with you in 2011 and we look forward to a successful 2012.

It is my privilege as the Director of the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control to welcome you to the 79th New Jersey Licensed Beverage Association's Convention in Atlantic City. I congratulate your membership and your Executive Director, Diane Weiss, for your efforts in putting on a great convention.

For the past 79 years, you have worked to foster the responsible use of alcohol and, through good business practices, you have preserved the integrity of the liquor license. Through the years, the relationship between the industry and the Division has also grown, and I, like you, am proud of our many mutual accomplishments. Together, we have effectively balanced the public's health, safety and welfare with the economic foundation upon which the liquor industry is built.

In this last year, the ABC has made great strides in its educational outreach and enforcement initiatives. These two priorities, while seemingly different in execution, are similar, and vital, in spirit. They allow the Division to keep channels of communication open with residents and business and also help maintain its public safety outreach.

Last month, the Division kicked-off its fifth annual "Proms and Alcohol Don't Mix" initiative. The program invites high school students to create a 30-second TV public service announcement. This program was created to open a dialogue among students and their teachers about the effects drinking can have on their prom experience. Second, the ABC and its partners recently selected winners of its annual Dangers of Underage Drinking billboard and calendar competition. The selection committee received several thousand submissions from middle school students for this art competition.

The Division has also been at the forefront of eliminating high-grade fake IDs, which have been in circulation. To the naked eye, these overseas-made fake IDs are indistinguishable from the genuine article and also are easily read by commercial scanners used by many businesses. However, through the use of new mobile data terminals, law enforcement has been able to identify the fraudulent IDs and arrest those who carry them.

With the support and participation of retail licensees, the Division has maintained its efforts to combat underage drinking, including the Cops in Shops program. This effort partners retail liquor stores with local police, as they work together to stop underage individuals from attempting to purchase alcohol. Since the program began in 1996, more than 9,300 individuals have been arrested. I would like to thank the licensees who have supported this effort for the past 15 years and have helped to make this a nationally recognized program.

Best wishes to you for a successful convention, and I look forward to working closely with you in 2012.
